INFORMATION & SERVICES FOR VISITING BOATS

The Harbourmaster can be contacted on 07778 601237 (harbour office) or VHF channel 8 when on the water.

Mooring fees can be paid on the water to the Harbourmaster (cash only) or at the Island Office.

Anchoring is not permitted within a line joining New Grimsby Quay and the western end of Plumb Island, and from Old Blockhouse across to the Sea Garden Cottages (see map overleaf). Vessels regularly transit between the quays; approaches must be kept clear and wash is to be expected in the areas surrounding quays.

Beaching is not permitted for any vessels (except tenders) without prior permission from the Harbourmaster.

Tenders should be left on the beach and not alongside the quay due to passenger and freight vessel movement.

Water is available on New Grimsby Quay and next to The Ruin Beach Café.

Petrol, gas and diesel are not available on Tresco, but are available on St Mary's.

Showers are available near the Island Office for the use of visiting yachts.

Refuse should be disposed of in the cage and recycling bins on New Grimsby and Old Grimsby quays. Please use appropriate recycling bins (clean paper or card/metal/glass/food waste).
